

ADMISSIONS PROCEDURE

The admission procedures at NUR ADARSHA SENIOR SECONDARY SCHOOL starts in November for the following classes:

PLAY CLASS: (ENGLISH MEDIUM):

As per NEW EDUCATION POLICY 2020, minimum age required 4 years and above. This is a basic foundation building class where a number of basic skills are taught through playway method which are essential for next LKG class

LKG CLASS: (ENGLISH MEDIUM):

Minimum age required 5 years and above

UKG CLASS: (ENGLISH MEDIUM):

Minimum age required 6 years and above.

CLASS I: (ENGLISH MEDIUM):

Minimum age required 7 years and above

N.B. Written and oral tests are taken for admission into higher classes.

SCHOOL CURRICULUM OVERVIEW

At NUR ADARSHA SISHU NIKETAN & Nur Academy our aim is to ensure that every child learns through access to a broad and balanced curriculum which is adapted to challenge and support individual children.

As per **NEW EDUCATION POLICY**, we strive to create a stimulating learning environment which will engage all children and make them want to learn. This means that they will develop a love of learning and a natural curiosity which will stay with them throughout their life.

We monitor children's progress and development carefully so that new skills and ideas can be introduced as soon as a child is ready to progress to the next stage of learning.

We believe that children learn most effectively from first hand experiences and we provide these through practical lessons and by offering a wide range of off-site learning enrichment opportunities.

Our curriculum provides opportunities for all pupils to learn and achieve and it promotes the pupils' spiritual, moral, social and cultural development. We know that the mental health and well-being of our children is critical to success in school and life. So education about mental health and well-being is an integral part of the school curriculum. We also ensure that we prepare pupils for the opportunities, responsibilities and experiences of life in modern INDIA.

Our planning for teaching and learning incorporates the Early Years Foundation Stage (PLAY & NURSERY) and the National Curriculum (Class I to XII).



SUBJECT OVERVIEWS

Computing

We teach and build opportunities for the use of computing in all subject areas by using interactive whiteboards, laptops and tablets.

The computing suite enables a class to work independently on a variety of packages such as Microsoft Office, educational programs, web and cloud based resources. Computational thinking is taught to all year groups. By the end of 10th grade children will have learnt to create animations, manipulate sound, code, blog, email, use Word, Powerpoint, spreadsheet skills and more.





DT (Design Technology)

As per the new education policy, **NUR ADARSHA SENIOR SECONDARY SCHOOL** has introduced design technology. linked to Science, History or Geography topics. DT (Design Technology) topics include food, materials, textiles and construction. Some examples of topics linked to History and Geography learning include – plant collages (Year 1), printing using leaves and flowers (Year 2), weaving a Celtic cloth (Year 3), constructing a river basin (Year 4), making and sampling Greek food (Year 5) and creating an Aztec mosaic (Year 6).

Music

From primary to high school, stage music is taught by an expert music teacher twice a week, from classical to modern songs.



Homework

We consider home learning as an opportunity to consolidate their learning from school. From 5th to 10th grade we encourage children to try their homework on their own to become independent learners. Because we understand the importance of preparing them for the transition to secondary school.



PE (Physical Education)

PE is taught for two hours a week and over the year the children take part in all kinds of sports activities. Extra-curricular sports opportunities are an important extension of our PE curriculum; the children, in primary to secondary level, have the opportunity to compete with other schools in hockey, athletics, handball, taekwondo, and scout guide training at district, state and national level.

It is extremely important that children attend school regularly and arrive on time.

Safety Rules We Follow

Children should be brought to school and collected by a guardian. We will not be able to let your child go with anyone else, unless we have had a message from you. Please make sure that we know how to contact you by telephone.

We ask you to avoid parking in the school corridor because of the danger to children walking and playing inside the school. There is a special parking place for bicycles and scooters in front of school. Your co-operation ensures the safety of the children and also the good relationship between the school and our neighbours. The main school gate is closed to all between 8:45am and 2:45pm and no one else is allowed inside during school hours unless there is an emergency. However, our office remains open throughout the day for parents and guests.


NUR SPORTS ACADEMY:


